Only one form is required per party.  20 April: Starting May 11, individuals who have been fully vaccinated in the State of Hawaii may travel inter-island without pre-travel testing or quarantining starting the 15th day after the completion of their vaccination.  20 January: The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has issued an order that goes into effect at 7:01 p.m. HST on Jan. 25, 2021 for all travelers flying to the U.S. from a foreign country.
