

## Background

The Logistics Cluster facilitates the coordination of the logistics response in support of the humanitarian community in South Sudan. It also provides information management products to improve the decision making of humanitarian organisations in South Sudan. Where logistics gaps are identified, WFP, as the lead agency of the Logistics Cluster, acts as a *Provider of Last Resort* by offering common logistics services to support the humanitarian community in their response operations.

## Operational Highlights

- In June, the Logistics Cluster facilitated the transport of **756 mt** of humanitarian cargo to **52 destinations**, of which **46 per cent was transported by river and road**. A total of **44 organisations** were supported.
- During the month, the Logistics Cluster coordinated the departure of two humanitarian convoys transporting a total of about **840 mt of NFIs from Juba to destinations along the Western Corridor**.
- The Logistics Cluster erected one **new Mobile Storage Unit (MSU) in Tonj North**, one of the Priority 1 counties for the multi-sectoral response scale up for highly food insecure areas. 240 m<sup>2</sup> of common storage space is now available to humanitarian organisations operating in the area.
- A third Mobile Storage Unit was set up in Akobo, also a Priority 1 county. The total **common storage space in Akobo is 720 m<sup>2</sup>**. All locations with common storage are displayed on the [Concept of Operations map](#).


## Coordination and Information Management

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, coordination meetings are held online for both Juba and the Logistics Cluster field hubs. In June, two regular coordination meetings were held, one in Juba and one in Wau. In addition, a **Special Focus coordination meeting on river transport** was held, where organisations could discuss their experiences and logistical challenges regarding river transport. A total of **22 organisations participated** in the meetings in June.

## Logistics Preparedness & COVID-19 Logistics Cluster Support

- WFP, through the Logistics Cluster, as a co-lead of the Operational Support and Logistics Pillar of the National COVID-19 Response Plan, continues to coordinate requests for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) from humanitarian organisations. As of 30 June 2021, 514 requests have been approved, allocating more than **9.5 million PPE items** from the common pool created by WHO, WFP and IOM, to be received in more than 250 locations across South Sudan.
