#### **Minutes of Meeting**

#### 1. Welcome members

At 1600hrs Mark Phillips welcomed and thanked the members for participating in the local TWG meetings.

Thanks to UNICEF for hosting the meeting.

#### 2. Completing contact detail sheeting participants

All participants were requested to complete the contact detail sheets, from this a TWG mailing list will be comprised, where correspondence, questions and answers can be distributed between the members.

#### 3. Update of the Gonaives project status.

Mark Phillips gave an update on the current status:

- As per decision of the UNCT and the RC common Security and Data communications will be provided in Gonaives only.
- Gonaives:
  - o The "Cyber Cafe" BGAN has now been replaced with a BitSAT. This will reduce running costs from an estimate of \$10k per month to \$650 USD per month.
  - The Inter agency radio room has now been established in the WFP port office location (the temp will stay in MINUSTAH, until the WFP office move has been completed).
  - In Gonaives VHF channel 1 and 6 are operational.
  - WFP are currently recruiting 5x Radio operators for Gonaives.
  - The WFP/FITTEST team will now start the handover to the WFP Haiti ICT team. Which in turn will also main stream the working environment to ensure long term sustainability.
- The effort of harmonisation of the HF network throughout the country continues.
- Standard code plugs have now been issued to all agencies via the TWG.

# 4. Open discussion on the current radio network and usage / questions and answers session.

In a similar line to the previous meetings, a very good open discussion was had by all attendees. With the main aim of understanding the current network and any additional requirements caused through the current emergency.

  - Run the agency radio rooms / radio network in Port au Prince and Gonaives.
  - Expand the VHF repeater network to cover the South (i.e. Les Cayes and Jacmel).
- o Continue the TWG meetings and involve more participants from other agencies / NGOs
- It was agreed by all attendees this meeting will now be held once monthly (the chair to be rotated between WFP and UNICEF ICT officers).
