

HODEIDAH PORT SNAPSHOT – YEMEN OPERATION

General Information

Hodeidah is the fourth largest city in Yemen, with a population of 400,000 people. It is the centre of the Al Hudaydah Governorate and is situated 4 km east from the Hodeidah Seaport.

Offloading capacity

- **Bulk cargos:**
 - Discharge through silo intake: 5,000 to 8,000 mt/day.
 - Discharge through dump trucks: 3,000 to 5,000 mt/day.
 - Discharge through bagging machines: 2,000 to 3,000 mt/day.
- **Break bulk cargos**
 - Small vessels (two cranes): 700 to 1,000 mt/day.
 - Large vessels (three cranes or more): 1,500 to 2,000 mt/day.

Following **airstrikes** in August 2015, the port can still receive container vessels even though five cranes were destroyed. To discharge and load containers, the ship cranes or rented cranes are currently being used.

Storage Capacity

Mobile Storage Units (480m²) located outside the port are made available to humanitarian organisations.

- **General:** **Covered Area:** 13 sheds with a total covered area of 36,400 m².
Open Area: 1,333,500 m² of open storage area
- **Cold Chain:** An area for reefers containers can have electricity is available
- **Containers:** Overall container capacity: 15,000 containers
Internal yard alongside the container terminal: 6,500 containers

Additional Information

- Saleef port is currently operational, although the port can only accommodate two vessels at a time.
