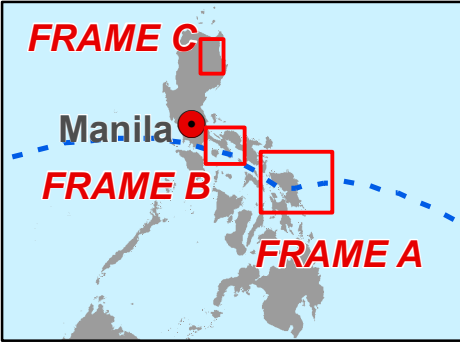
Tacloban Airport
